The Art of Dean Wyatt

Dean Wyatt, a Tulsa native currently residing in Owasso, focuses primarily on abstract forms. Although his pieces are often interpreted as landscapes, he says, "Although I can certainly see those elements in my work, when I'm painting, the landscape aspect is secondary — I'm more focused on the mood, the emotion of the piece."

Wyatt exhibits regularly in local group and solo exhibitions. His work was selected for exhibition in the 2005 Oklahoma Painting and Drawing Biennial, the Mayfest Invitational Gallery in 2006 and 2007, and this year's Blue Invitational, OVAC Biennial IX and Philbrook Festival of Trees. Wyatt currently serves as president of the Tulsa Artists' Coalition.
